School uniform reminder

Our School Uniform is important to us with smartness and high standards of appearance expected at all times. All children should wear the uniform and we encourage them to maintain an acceptable standard of clean and tidy dress in school.

Our winter School Uniform consists of:

- Maroon school jumper / school cardigan / school sweatshirt
- Plain white or light blue polo shirt
- Dark grey trousers. Please note that leggings should not be worn instead of trousers
- Dark grey skirt or pinafore
- Plain black/grey tights or black/grey/white socks

Footwear

• Flat, smart black shoes or smart black trainers with no markings or other colours. School shoes should be suitable for both indoors and active play outdoors. Coloured trainers should not be worn.

Boots:
