

After School Sailing Club

Dear Parents,

We are delighted to be able to continue with the after school sailing club which is run by Camel Sailing in Rock. The first session will be on **Monday 24th April** and the club will run through the summer term.

The club, which is open to children in years 4, 5 and 6, will run as a weekly two hour session every Monday from 4.15-6.15pm and thanks to The Aspire Academy Trust and Padstow Harbour Commission who will be subsidising the cost, the club will be **FREE**.

The Harbour Commission have also agreed to allow ferry transport to and from the sailing club for free. It will be your responsibility to get your child to and from the ferry/sailing school. Many of our parents drop their children to the ferry and collect them later from the slipway.

Your child will need to take swimwear, a towel and boots/shoes that you are happy for them to get wet as well as warm clothes for afterwards. Children can bring their own wetsuits if they wish, but they are provided by the sailing school.

There are 15 places available which will be given on a first come, first served basis. If your child is interested, please complete and return the reply slip below **to the school office (not the class teachers)**.

We will issue your child with a ferry pass and a medical form if they are successful in gaining a place.
