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Padstow School Behaviour Policy

This week, we have introduced a new Behaviour Policy which is intended to support every member of the school community with feeling valued and respected, and for all persons to be treated fairly and where all feel happy, safe and secure.

Padstow School wants all its pupils to be increasingly confident and independent – to care for themselves, to be responsible for their personal safety, to develop self-esteem, to take responsibility for their own actions and to take pride in their achievements. We believe that self-esteem affects all thinking and behaviour, impacting on learning and performance.

The emphasis of the School's discipline policy is on REWARD and PRAISE, which will be given whenever possible for both work and behaviour. We believe a positive approach is best where good discipline arises from good relationships and from setting expectations of good behaviour.

As a reminder, the school's Rules for Life are:

1. Show respect and good manners at all times
2. Follow instructions with thought and care
3. Care for everyone and everything
