PE:

To improve their ball skills (throw, roll, catch and strike) and to implement these skills in games.

<u>Music</u>

Ice Music and Sea Shanties.

Taking inspiration from music from the Arctic region and to learn and sing songs from their locality.

To develop their understanding of pulse and rhythm and to begin to explore how the elements of music combine to produce an effect.

Art / Design Technology:

Using Innuit art as inspiration they will use the block printing technique and experiment with the technique and refine their print.
