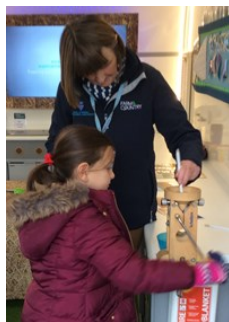


Prices are **£1.50** for entry, a drink and a bag of sweets.
