The School Day

The school doors open at 8.50am. The playground is supervised for children from this time. Registration is at 9am followed by a literacy session at 9.05am. Assembly is from 9.55-10.15am. Break time is from 10.15-10.30am. Lunch time is 12.25-1.25pm. The school day ends at 3.15pm If your child cannot attend school on any day, please inform us before 9.30am that morning by a phone call or email.
