Hook-

We're going out and about on a minibeast hunt.

Let's sweep our nets in ponds and lift up logs to see who's home. Then we'll set up a minibeast laboratory and observe their every move, just like a real entomologist.

PE:

Athletics

We will be learning to throw, run and jump over obstacles, learning to pace ourselves for longer runs and begin to confidently apply these skills.

Art and Design:

We will be learning to produce creative work, exploring their ideas through observational drawings and investigation of camouflage in nature. We will be using a range of materials creatively to design and make our very own mini-beasts.

English:

Information text - Guide book.

Cross curricular writing—

Fact writing, instructions, labels, lists and explanations.

History and Geography:

We will be learning to use a compass to understand direction. We will be using these skills to create a local map. We will create a key to help identify human and physical features of the landscape.

RE:

We will be exploring the question:
Who is Muslim and how do they live?

We will be learning about what Muslims think about God and what can we learn from Muslim holy words. We will also be looking a the questions; What makes some people and places in Cornwall sacred?

Outdoor Learning:

We will be exploring shape in nature and using the outdoor classroom throughout the Summer term.

Science:

Living things and their habitats

We will be exploring and watching the life cycle of a Butterfly. We will be learning about habitats and how these habitats provide the basic needs for different kinds of animals. We will start to identify and name a variety of plants and animals that live in these habitats and how they obtain their food using the idea of a food chain.

We will be learning about who helps us grow (people who look after us) and what things we can now do by ourselves, that we couldn't do when we were younger.

We will continue with our African drumming lessons. We will learn to play poly-rhythms and keep to the beat. We will perform a song to the school.
