DINOSAUR PLANET

<u>The Hook!</u>

Let's go out into the woods today... What will we find? Where did those foot prints come from? Is that a nest? Let's use our tools to excavate and explore.

<u>Science:</u>

We will be observing changes across the four seasons and describing weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

We will be using our questioning and observation skills to look closely at fossils and teeth. Is it a plant eater or meat eater?

<u>Literacy:</u>

Fiction—The Dirty Great Dinosaur

Captions, labels and speech.

History and Geography:

To learn about Mary Anning and to look at images of her fossil discoveries. To investigate what happened to the dinosaurs and to use the world map to locate countries and continents of animals at risk of extinction.

<u>Music</u>:

To change lyrics to well know rhymes to create a new dinosaur song. To use voices to explore sounds they think dinosaurs may have made and incorporate these into their new lyrics. To add a sound track to their dinosaur songs using percussion instruments,
