Well done Archie!

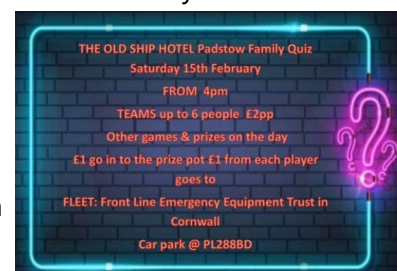


Fund-raising for FLEET
