<u>PE:</u>

We will be developing our balance and coordination through performing dances using simple movements. We will begin by exploring moods and feelings related to colours and then move onto the seasons by experimenting with actions, levels and a growing range of movements.

English:

We will be exploring the questions: What is the 'good news' Christians say Jesus brings?

Why does Christmas matter to Christians?

Art and Design:

We will be exploring the art work by Carl Warner, exploring what happens when colours mix on water, and investigating how the properties of clay changes as more water is added. We will be creating mixed media pictures.

<u>Science:</u>

To find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

To find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air). To describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food,
