

Further to our mention of the character Huggy Wuggy in a newsletter before the holidays, we would like to flag this up again: the sinister 'teddy bear' character is from a PC game called Poppy Playtime, a horror video game featuring frightening images and themes. Although children won't be able to play the game itself unless they have paid for and downloaded it, there are multiple YouTube videos featuring content from the game and copy-cat games on the internet.


