Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you all had a rested half term together and are ready for the second half of the spring term ahead. A huge THANK YOU must go to yourselves and the children for your continued hard work at home and at school. We know how difficult it has been for many of you juggling home schooling, home life and work. We have been humbled and impressed at how hard our children have worked and adapted to learning in a different way. Once again, our many thanks and praise to our Padstow School Community for making it happen!

Our topic this half term is 'Misty Mountain, Winding River'. We are exploring geographical aspects including river sources, formation, and journeys. Mountains of the world, their flora and fauna and how humans use and interact with both rivers and mountains. We will be exploring this topic through art and geography, hopefully getting out (when safe to do so) and being practical in our exploration.

Attached to this letter is a topic web to give you a brief overview of what will be covered in each subject until the end of this half term, and some optional 'Home Learning' ideas if those on Google classroom are not enough or you would like a change.

Reading

Your child's class reading book has been linked to their reading ability and their understanding is continually monitored through reading tests based on their book. This book can be changed when the children have achieved an 80% pass rate in their reading knowledge test about that book. If your child needs a new accelerated reading book please let us know and we will choose a new one for them and arrange for you to collect this from the drop box.

Children need to read 5 times a week. PLEASE remember to log down your daily reading at home in the Reading Dairy. We will reward children when they get back into school, by checking all the fabulous home reading they have achieved since we last saw them.

The children all have their spellings and reading to be completed weekly, and times tables to practice. The list of optional home learning ideas to share with your child

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linked to 'Misty Mountain, Winding River' is also available on our class web page. Other home learning activities will be updated daily on Google Classroom and Sum Dog maths tasks are set regularly. Please ask if you need a reminder of your child's log on.

Spellings and times tables

A half termly spelling sheet is attached as a separate letter. The first spelling test will be Friday 28^{th} February and then every Friday until end of term.

Year 3 will be learning their 3, 6, 4 and 8-times tables this year.

Year 4 children will be recapping their 6- and 7 and 9-times tables and learning their 12-times table by the end of the year.
