Safeguarding information

Wadebridge Police have received a report that a young boy was followed home by 2 males in a white van, on Tuesday evening. The boy had the good sense to run to a nearby house. One of the males shouted out to the boy, while they were following him. While this type of incident is rare, Police are asking parents to speak with their children and asking them to safeguard themselves as best they can. Examples of this are not walking home from school or going out alone, having their mobile phone to hand, if they have one, and if they do see anyone acting suspiciously, to report it straight away. All of the schools in the Wadebridge area have been notified and have been asked to send out a message to their students or parents to be extra vigilant.
