Each week, we ask you to support your child with their number bonds. Number bonds are pairs of numbers added together to make another number. They help children to understand that a number such as 10 can be made by a range of different pairs such as 5+5 and 2+8. Knowing and understanding the relationship between number bond pairs can really support your child with the mental arithmetic involved in adding and subtracting. You can teach number bonds in a range of different ways. Please find some suggestions below:

- Make number cards can your child find matching pairs?
- Play Bingo
- Use objects and split them into two groups. Can your child record (on paper/on a whiteboard/using chalk etc) all the different ways they find of splitting them.

- https://www.ictgames.com/saveTheWhale/index.html an interactive game where you need to know your number bonds to save the whale. (You can adjust what number you are focusing on from 5-10).
- Play find the missing number- 5+?= 10. What number helps 5 to make 10 etc.
- Build a tower using blocks can your child find how many blocks are missing to
 make the total? For example, when learning number bonds to 8, you could build a
 tower of 5 blocks; how many more would they need to make 8? (Having one
 colour for bricks in the tower and another for the missing bricks could help to
 support your child to see the 2 numbers)
