A date for your diary for next summer: the national SATs tests are planned for Monday 9th to Thursday 12th May 2022.

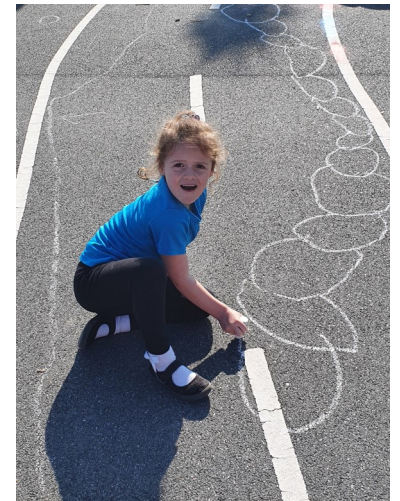


Lunchtime fun at school

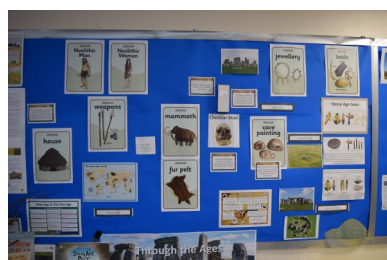
