We will be learning about Place Value within 10.

We will count one more or one less from any given number to 10.

We will compare groups.

We will be learning about addition and subtraction with 10.

We will use the part-part-whole method.

We will find number bonds for numbers within 10.

English

There will be a range of fiction and nonfiction books about adventures and exploring.

We will continue to learn the RWI Set 1 & 2 sounds and apply them in our reading and writing.

We will be sharing the story 'We're going on a bear hunt', making our own story maps.

We will be learning how to say a sentence before writing it.

We will work on becoming independent writers by writing down the sounds we can hear in words.

We will focus on writing sentences using finger spaces, full stops and capital letters.

We will learn how to use descriptive words (adjectives) in our writing.

We will design our own fantasy worlds.
