Let's Explore the World

Geography:

We will be learning to use an atlas to find out about the world's continents. Learn about the four cardinal compass points, and use a key to read a map. We will learn about the equator, the Northern and Southern Hemispheres and the North and South Poles. We will learn about the four countries in the United Kingdom.

PE:

Multi Skills

We are learning to improve basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.

Computing:

We will explore direction and movement through creating and debugging simple programs (Bee Bots).

English:

Non—Fiction - Stories from other cultures

'Monkey See, Monkey Do!'

<u>Cross curricular writing</u>—labels and captions and instruction writing.

PSHE

Keeping myself safe

We will be learning about how to keep ourselves healthy, safe and unsafe secrets, appropriate touch and medicine safety.

Design and technology:

Vehicles to explore

We will be learning to name and explore a range of everyday products and describe how they are used and how they could be improved. We will learning to use wheels and axles to make a simple moving model.

Music:

How Does Music Make the World a Better Place?

We will be learning about the meaning of dynamics and tempo and be able to demonstrate these when singing by responding to the leaders' directions and visual symbols (e.g. crescendo, decrescendo and pause).

Science:

Humans

We will learn that humans are a type of animal, known as a mammal. We will name body parts and recognise common structures between humans and other animals. We will learn about the senses, the body parts associated with each sense and their role in keeping us safe.

We will begin to describe the importance for humans of exercise, diet and hygiene.

Seasonal Changes

We will begin to observe changes across the four season and describe weather associated with season and how day length varies.

RE-Christianity

What do Christians believe God is like?

We will be learning about parables and why they are important to Christians. We will looking at how Christians put their beliefs into practice.

Outdoor Learning:

We will be working on our teamwork, cooperation, and communication..

We will be using locational and direction language to explore the school grounds. We will create and follow trails and make our own natural maps.
