Learning Objective for this unit of work: I can read, spell and understand a range of homophones.

A homophone is a word that sounds the same as another but is spelt differently (e.g. mail, male; to, too, two). Children will be learning that sound is not necessarily an indication of spelling. Children will need to learn how to spell these words and their meaning so they can be used correctly - we will be concentrating on this in class. At home, children should practise by using them in sentences.
