This term we are going to start with a week focused on Bonfire Night before moving on to our topic 'Why do squirrels hide their nuts?'. Reading

Please ensure that this file stays in their bookbag so we can practise reading their words in school and so we can add new words and challenges for you to support them at home. When you share your child's book, practise their sounds or words in their homework file, please note this in your child's reading record so we can see what you have been doing at home. Many thanks.

<u>P.E.</u>

P.E. will continue to be taught on Friday mornings. This term we are going to be focusing on gymnastics where the children will learn some basic shapes and balances and how to jump and land safely. Just as the older year groups are doing, we ask that your child comes in to school every Friday dressed in their P.E. kit (please find the Uniform Policy on the website) which they will wear all day. Please be mindful that the children will still be going out to break times as normal so tracksuit bottoms/tops (as stated in the Policy, these should be plain black) and waterproof trainers rather than plimsolls/ pumps would be beneficial given the likely weather.
